# **√** Bus Assignments

To be eligible to ride a public school bus, a student must reside two or more miles from their assigned school, be a participant in a designated Exceptional Education Program with an active Individual Education Plan (IEP) or an approved 504 Plan.

Elementary students who reside within two miles of their assigned school but do not have a pedestrian route that is free of hazards from home to school, as defined by Florida law, may also qualify for busing.
